Premium Burial Options

Centennial Park offers four premium burial options suitable for both burials and ashes. All options are set in tranquil spaces with serene gardens creating a peaceful atmosphere, ideal for personal reflection.

Olive Terrace

With views stretching from the Adelaide Hills to the sea, Olive Terrace is one of Centennial Park’s most sought-after premium burial areas. With a peaceful water feature, aromatic olive trees and vibrant seasonal plantings, this fully irrigated space offers comfortable seating, shaded areas and an elegant gazebo. A calm and contemplative setting for families and visitors to pause, reflect and remember. Vaults, prefabricated concrete grave, have provision for up to three (3) burials and up to six (6) sets of ashes per position.

Full monuments of polished granite available in this area, 1800mm H x 1390mm W x 2835mm D.

Martinique Grove 2

Featuring a distinctive granite-enclosed design, Martinique Grove 2 is centered around a calming cluster of fragrant Magnolia trees. When in bloom, their striking white flowers bring a sense of serenity and natural beauty to the space. Fully irrigated and complemented by a gazebo for shelter and contemplation, this premium area offers a gentle, reflective setting to honour and remember a loved one.

Contemporary garden style earth burial position for up to three (3) burials and six (6) sets of ashes, with provision for bronze or ceramic plaque, 305mm H x 610mm W.

General Vaults

For families seeking a vault burial rather than an earth burial, Centennial Park offers a limited number of concrete vaults within the General Vault area. This option provides a practical alternative while maintaining the same standards of care, dignity and respect that guide everything we do.

Burial vaults, prefabricated concrete graves, with provision for three (3) interments with standard headstones on a beam, 840mm H x 1150mm maximum W x 70mm D.

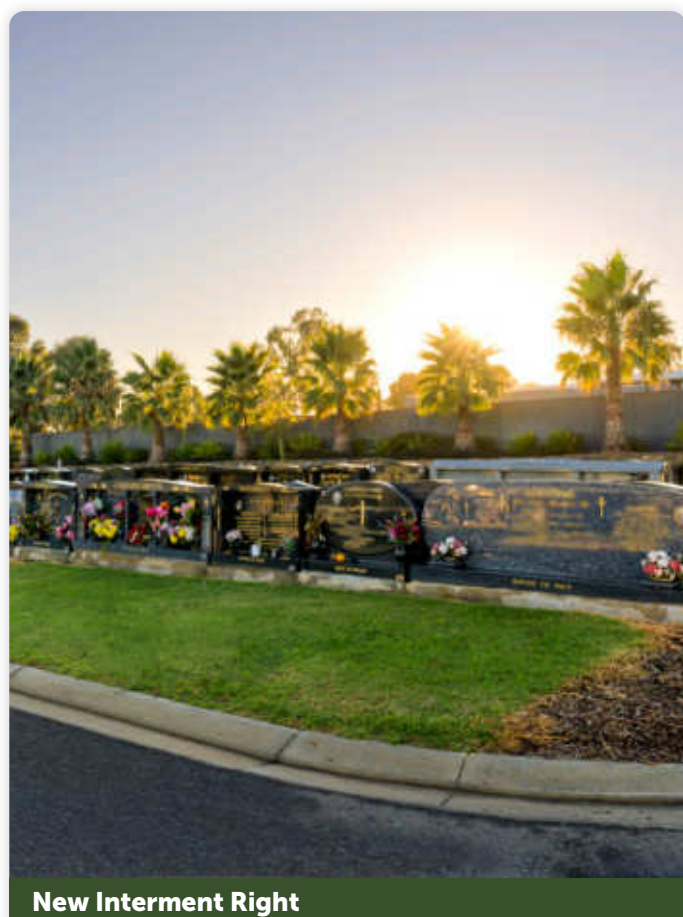

The Views

Lined with statuesque pencil pines and flourishing dwarf pomegranates, The Views is a beautifully landscaped premium burial area designed to mature gracefully over time. With seating positioned to take in expansive views of both the hills and the sea, this fully irrigated space offers a peaceful environment where families can spend time together in quiet reflection.

The Views provides earth burials for up to three (3) burials and six (6) sets of ashes, with provision for a large monument, 1800mm H x 910mm W x 400mm D.

Burial Options

Classic (non-irrigated)

Standard sized burial positions offer a headstone on a beam, including areas for specific religions such as Bahá'í, Catholic, Druze, Lutheran, Maronite, Muslim, Orthodox, Orthodox Jewish and Progressive Jewish faiths.

Classic earth burial position has provision for standard-size headstone 840mm H x 900mm W x 70mm D.

Preloved Classic (non-irrigated)

A Preloved Classic is a position that has been reclaimed by Centennial Park. Existing interments are placed in a memorial vessel at a lower depth to allow for three (3) new interments. Provision for standard size headstone on beam 840mm H x 900mm W x 70mm D.

Wide Headstone

Specifically developed to facilitate larger coffins or caskets, as well as a wider headstone. Available in both irrigated and non-irrigated areas of the Park.

Provision for wider headstone on beam, 840mm H x 1150mm W x 70mm D. Maximum size limits apply.

Simple and fully irrigated ensuring year-round lush surroundings. Distinguished by unobtrusive, beautifully uniform sloping granite headstones.

Earth burial position with provision for sloper style headstone, 150mm H x 660mm W.

Derrick Gardens (irrigated)

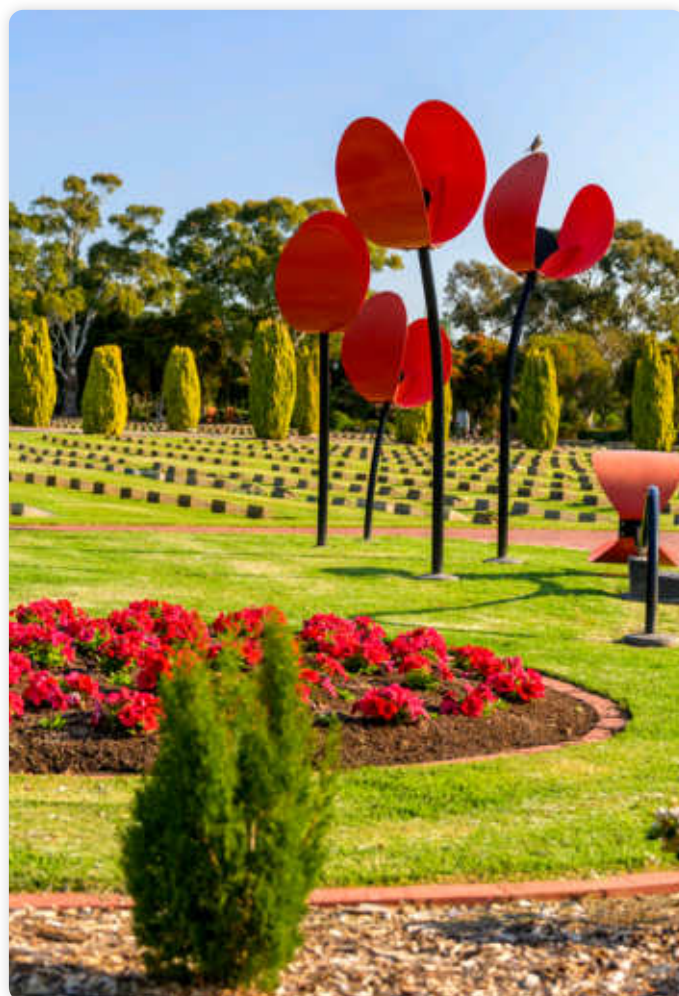
Established in 1956 Derrick Gardens is named after WWII Victoria Cross recipient Lieutenant Thomas "Diver" Derrick and is a specifically designated area for returned or current service personnel.

Approval by the Office of Australian War Graves is required for interments into Derrick Gardens.

Sloper style headstone, 150mm H x 660mm W, required for each service person's interment (maximum of two (2) headstones per position).

Infants and Children

Centennial Park has two burial options which are specifically designed for families that have lost a child. Both areas are fully irrigated and allow for one interment in each position.

Perinatal Infant

For interments of perinatal infants up to 28 days old, with provision for a small plaque on the beam. Perinatal twins can be interred in the same coffin.

For interments of children up to and including three (3) years of age, with provision for a small upright headstone, 440mm H x 530mm W.

Required Burial Services

Fees for the preparation of the burial position, placement of the coffin/casket within the designated area, and the closure of the burial position after interment.

Burial service includes one canopy and 12 chairs complimentary from Centennial Park.

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Monuments

Monuments are not included in our burial fees and are an additional cost, arranged directly with a monumental mason of your choice.

As the interment right holder, you own the monument and are responsible for its design, installation and ongoing care.

To ensure the integrity and harmony of our grounds, the installation of a monument (such as a headstone), or the addition of an inscription to an existing monument, must be approved by Centennial Park.

All monumental work must be carried out by an authorised monumental mason and is subject to a permit fee.

Any monument installed without prior approval or authorisation will be removed.

General Burial Information

New Burial Interment Rights

Interment Rights for new burial positions are issued for a minimum of 50 years, with the option to choose a longer term or perpetuity (forever).

To help you make an informed and comfortable choice, it is essential to arrange an appointment to select a new burial position. Burial locations vary across the Park, if features such as irrigation, shade or seating are important to you, please let your memorial consultant know.

Some areas of Centennial Park have specific monumental requirements. Understanding these requirements before purchasing a position helps ensure your choices align with the location you select.

Before a burial can take place, a Plain English Statement (CCASA Form) must be completed by the proposed Interment Right Holder. To arrange an appointment, please contact our team on 08 8276 6011.

Repositioning Existing Burials

An Interment Right Holder may request that existing burials be repositioned to a lower level, known as a Lift and Deepen Procedure, as defined in the Burial and Cremation Act 2013 (SA). This may occur when:

- Earlier interments do not allow for further burials, and at least three years have passed since the most recent burial.
- Where there are three interments in a grave, repositioning for additional burials may occur if at least 40 years have passed since the most recent burial and the Interment Right is held in perpetuity.

Preloved Burial

A Preloved Classic is a burial position that has been reclaimed by Centennial Park. Existing interments are respectfully placed into a memorial vessel at a lower level, allowing space for new interment(s).

This option provides families with additional choice, while ensuring all interments are treated with dignity and respect.

Additional Tenure

Anyone may renew or extend an Interment Right by adding additional years (tenure), with a minimum renewal period of 5 years.

Perpetuity (forever)

A perpetual Interment Right ensures a burial or ashes memorial will remain in place forever, with no requirement for future generations to renew the right.

Interment Right Holder

The rights and responsibilities of the Interment Right Holder are clearly outlined in the Plain English Statement. Families are asked to carefully decide who will hold the Interment Right, as only the Interment Right Holder can authorise interments, monumental work, including headstones, inscriptions and plaques.

Transfer of Interment Right Declaration Form

A Transfer of an Interment Right can only occur with the approval of Centennial Park.

A Transfer of Interment Right Declaration Form must be submitted before a transfer can take place, and before a grave is re-opened for an additional burial when the Interment Right Holder is deceased.
